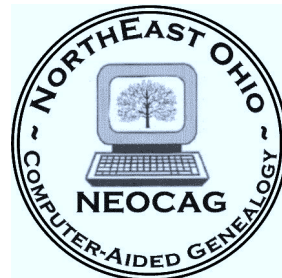

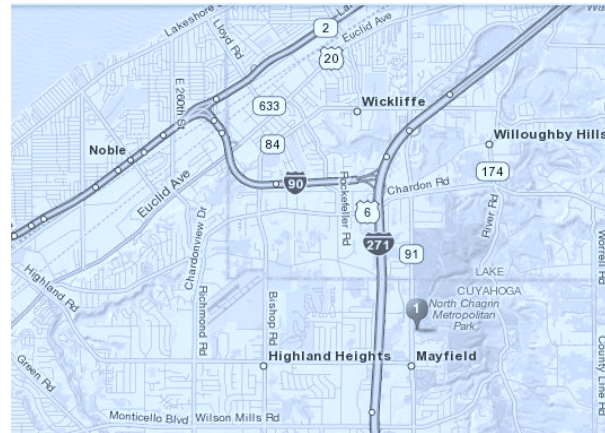

St. Bartholomew Episcopal Church
435 SOM Center Road, South of I-90
and North of Wilson Mills Road.

From I-90: Exit at Route 91, turn South. The church is just past (i.e. South) of Metropolitan Park North Chagrin Reservation on the left (East) side of SOM Center Road.

From I-271: Exit at Wilson Mills, go East 1/2 mile to Route 91 (SOM Center Road), turn left (North) onto SOM Center Road. The church is on the right side of the road across the street from and just before a water slide park on the left.
